This workshop is designed for those professionals who need an introduction to the basic rules of administration, scoring, and interpretation of the BDI2. This training is designed for those familiar or unfamiliar with the original BDI. Participants are asked to bring test books, test records, examiner's manuals and related materials to the training session.

The participants will:

- ♥ Receive an overview of the new edition with an emphasis on the changes from the original BDI.
- ♥ Review the validity, reliability, and key features of the BDI2.
- ♥ Review each of the domains and sub-domains.
- ♥ Learn general rules of administration and scoring, use of basals and ceilings, and calculation of raw scores.
- ♥ Learn the three procedures and the process of administering and scoring individual items by the different procedures.
- ♥ Learn the procedure for hand-scoring and plotting the domains and sub-domains on the test record.
- ♥ Become familiar with the features and reports available through use of the computer scoring program.
- ♥ Learn basic interpretation techniques with case studies.

Presenter: Jim Creed, LD specialist and trainer for the WJ-III, has taught regular education classes, run special education programs at the high school and middle school levels, and coordinated group assessment activities for a city school district. He has also taught courses in educational assessment at the graduate level, helping students to develop knowledge of theories of cognitive processing from both historical and contemporary perspectives. First and foremost he is a practitioner, conducting educational assessments for public and private school systems. In the effort to provide total quality assessment throughout the process, he strives to discover and use the best tools available.
