## ***Strategies for the Development of Phonological Processing Across the Curriculum and Ages: A Critical Dimension of Literacy***

This workshop will initially present definitions and research related to phonological processing with a brief overview of the developmental process. Then a range of strategies will be presented for word, syllable and sound awareness and manipulation with active participation in activities. Connections to reading, literature, written language, and spelling will be made. Differentiation of strategies based on learner needs and ages will be modeled.

### ***Outcomes:***

- Define phonological processing and phonemic awareness.
- Outline the developmental sequence of skills.
- Describe 2-3 strategies for word, syllable, and phoneme levels of intervention.
- State specific strategies that can be connected to one or more areas of study, such as reading, spelling, or written language
