The Developmental, Individual Difference, Relationship-based (DIR®/Floortime™) Model is a framework that helps clinicians, parents, and educators conduct a comprehensive assessment and develop an intervention program tailored to the unique challenges and strengths of children with Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD) and other developmental challenges. The objectives of the DIR®/Floortime™ Model are to build healthy foundations for social, emotional, and intellectual capacities rather than focusing on skills and isolated behaviors. It was developed by Stanley Greenspan, M.D., and Serena Wieder, Ph.D.

Participants in this fun, interactive, and informative session will be provided an overview of the model, strategies in Floortime, opportunities for role play, and active discussion around this model and autism.
