Increasing demands on educators' time, less money for professional development, and soaring gas prices have led us to look at alternatives for capacity building. This program of learning is presented via a conference call so that professionals do not have to leave their sites to participate in learning and practice new skills. TelePD is built on the foundation of what we know to be effective professional development: site-based activity with a clear purpose, ongoing and embedded in the work of the school.

Teams are the cornerstones of organizations. Businesses have executive teams, management teams, department teams, and project teams. Schools have administrative teams, leadership teams, vertical teams, horizontal teams, and professional learning teams. Yet how much professional development have we invested in making sure teams have the skills needed to solve a variety of problems and be successful? In this session we will use Patrick Lencioni's framework from *The Five Dysfunctions of a Team* to explore how teams build trust, lean into conflict, and focus on results.

Participants will:

- ♥ Gather strategies for productive teams.
- ♥ Learn to lean into conflict.
- ♥ Become revitalized from hands-on work, sharing, and learning.

Directions: Participants will need access to long distance calling, preferably a plan with unlimited minutes. A week before class, participants will be provided with session handouts, TelePD protocols, and the call-in number.

Fee: \$15 for a one hour session. Because of the low enrollment fee, no registration discounts are offered for these sessions and there will be no reimbursement for missed calls.

Presenter and On-site Facilitator: Ann Pike is an educational consultant/coach and has experience leading this type of professional development. She has served for 30+ years as a classroom teacher; as a supervisor for undergraduate students; a grant writer and director; and as a staff developer. She has taken courses at Coach U and the Graduate School of Coaching. During the past 8 years, Ann has been designing learning opportunities, courses, institutes, and workshops for teachers and administrators through the Western Maine Partnership, SEED, and the Maine Support Network.
