Interactive Word Walls: Making the Vocabulary Come Alive

This workshop will focus on the what, when, where and how of interactive word walls. Participants will be provided with a range of possible word walls and how to construct them. A variety of activities to use with word walls will be modeled with audience participation. Strategies will focus on vocabulary, but additional strategies will include word work (e.g., phonics and phonemic awareness), orthography and writing activities.

Outcomes:

- ♥ Define "interactive word wall."
- ♥ Describe ways to construct a word wall, types of word walls and when to use word walls.
- ♥ Describe 5-10 vocabulary activities to use with the word wall.
- ♥ Describe specific word work activities to use with the word wall.
- ♥ Outline plans for an interactive word wall.
